CURRICULUM	<p>Required: HONRS 292R or HONRS 110: Introduction to Great Questions 3 Interdisciplinary courses (UNIV 291, UNIV 292, UNIV 293 - 9 credits)</p> <p>Recommended: WRTG 150H, Advanced Math & GE Foreign Language</p> <p>Transfer/late-joining students with 30+ hours do not need to take HONRS 292R/HONRS 110 Transfer/late-joining students with 60+ hours only need to take 2 Interdisciplinary courses</p>
EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING	<p>HONRS 390: Honors Peer Mentoring OR Cambridge Direct Enrollment Program, or approved university-sponsored Study Abroad, Field Study, or International Internship program OR Academic Service (Tutoring, University Accessibility Center, Y-Serve Program)</p>
GREAT QUESTIONS	<p>HONRS 310: Great Questions Tutorial plus <i>Great Questions Essay</i></p>
PORTFOLIO	<p>Bound Honors portfolio that includes <i>Great Questions Essay</i>, Honors thesis, and a brief personal reflection about the Honors experience</p>
THESIS	<p>Original research or creative work/project - character, scope, and approval processes determined by student's home department</p>
THESIS DEFENSE	<p>At the discretion of student's home department</p>
THESIS BINDING	<p>Thesis to be included in bound Honors portfolio</p>
