- If for any reason I do not successfully complete and defend my honors thesis, my grade will remain a "T" on my transcript indefinitely. ("T" grades do not impact GPA.)*
- Only a **total of 6.0 credits** may ever be registered for by students over their Honors career (whether in one term or in more terms combined).
