Named after the founder of the BYU Honors Program, the Robert K. Thomas Scholarship (half-tuition) is awarded to committed BYU Honors students who:

1. are declared majors/minors in the Marriott School of Business
2. have completed at least 14.0 credits of required Honors coursework
3. have a minimum 3.5 cumulative grade-point average
4. have an approved Honors thesis proposal
5. demonstrate financial need, either through a completed a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form for the current academic year, or with a written explanation of financial need attached to application
6. will be enrolled for at least 2.0 credits spring/summer or 6.0 credits fall/winter.

Please do not apply if you do not meet the criteria described above.
